They have already built a bank, the town hall, and the new school with the sports hall. They organize the constructions of the new kindergarten and the communal sport grounds. Everything goes on according to plan, step by step.

The town hall should be an emblematic building. A symbol. A building of high European standards, that takes attention and expresses the honored function of a public building and the democratic openness towards its citizens. Inside we wanted to accentuate the same thing: the open relation of clients and officials. Instead of communication through little holes on the glass wall we put the client in focus – for whom and from whose taxpayings we built this office. So the open area for the clients is in the center of the building and we organized the administration rooms around this central space. 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


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
ground floor plan
