The last five years in the history of Pellérd can be a good example for everyone, I think. The leaders of the village and the mayor, József Metzinger have long-range plans. Seven years ago they have prepared a regulation concept that has shown up the conditions of a future village center. Later, they asked our office to make a study-plan of this center. As a result of this long lasting planning process Pellérd and its center now possesses a well prepared future development plan. They have already built a bank, the town hall, and the new school with the sports hall. They organize the constructions of the new kindergarten and the communal sport grounds. Everything goes on according to plan, step by step.

The first realized project was the bank with an intention to transform the single-storied main street up to a higher scale – even if the bank is single-story as well – and to help the turn the axis of the main-street towards the new east-west directed promenade. The narrative of the house was created by the locals – according to them it looked like a hive with its holes like hive-cells where the hard working bee-people of Pellérd collect their wealth. 


ground floor plan
